The music and movies of 3 white guys named John transcended race and lived experience to act as Divine messengers leading Andrea on the path of her destiny dropping lyrical and cinematic breadcrumbs along the way.

Andrea Coleman is a Brooklyn-based writer, performer and lawyer originally from Virginia. She writes sketch comedy, stand-up comedy, screenplays and stage plays. The law comedy show she created and stars in, "Wack or Woke? Andrea Coleman Judges the Law," has been featured in The New York Times, TimeOut NY, NPR and aired on PBS. Andrea practiced law for nearly 17 years for a Fortune 100 Company and has tried 30 jury trials. In NYC, Andrea has performed at Joe's Pub, RISK!, UCB, Comedy Cellar, Comic Strip, Gotham and Caroline's. 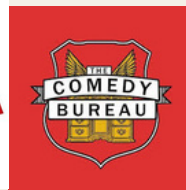
